Beginning in 1961, millions of patrons visited the Kahiki Supper Club, in Columbus, Ohio, for gourmet Asian and Polynesian cuisine. Over the years, the restaurant won numerous awards, including "The Best Polynesian Restaurant in the World" and "One of the Top 100 Restaurants of the 20th Century." In 2000, the restaurant was closed in order to focus on growing our then fledgling frozen food business.
